## Toddler News (Room 202):

As we continue into the Summer season, our toddlers will talk about outdoor safety. We will discuss the importance of wearing sunscreen and sun hats. We will learn how to take care of our environment by talking about proper plant care. The toddlers will discuss watering plants and being kind to nature. As we explore plant care, the toddlers will plant their own seeds and water them to help them grow. We will make observations as the plant grows as to the color change, as well as the change in the outward appearance. One area of focus for July will be music and dance. The toddlers will learn to celebrate and honor diversity by hearing songs from various cultures. The children will learn to move to the music as they learn about the rhythms from the songs.
